Academic Fellowship Program

2 YEAR The KSPP's fellowship program is a full-time on-the-job training opportunity that aims to develop aspiring scholars with the knowledge, skills, and networks needed to excel in academia in the field of public policy. Within two years, Fellows will progressively deepen their knowledge and expand their impact through a combination of research skills and courses, as well as mentoring, in preparation for pursuing a Ph.D. at leading international universities with a full scholarship, along with a post-Ph.D. career placement opportunity at KSPP.

By the end of the two-year Academic Fellowship Program, Fellows will have:



Developed a deep understanding of public policy.



Built a global network of peers, mentors, and collaborators.



Gained academic experience in public policy.



Positioned themselves for careers in academia.

Your Fellowship Pathway

The KSPP Fellowship is designed to guide you through each stage of your academic journey from initial eligibility to postdoctoral impact.

Join the Fellowship

Begin your academic career at KSPP by engaging in hands-on research opportunities and academic workshops to develop your skills and expertise



Secure Ph.D. Admission

Receive guidance and support to gain acceptance into a competitive doctoral program aligned with KSPP's areas of focus.



Pursue Your Ph.D. with Full Funding

Upon admission to a Ph.D. program and KSPP approval, your doctoral studies will be fully funded.



Return and Make an Impact
Following completion of your Ph.D., return to KSPP for at least one year as a faculty member to contribute.



Fellow Responsibilities

During the fellowship, participants will contribute actively to KSPP's academic and research community by:



Assisting with lecture preparation and curriculum development.



Collaborating with KSPP faculty and KAPSARC researchers on ongoing research projects.



Participating in academic workshops and professional development sessions.



Submitting an annual report detailing contributions and academic progress.

Who Should Apply?

Individuals who are ambitious and academically accomplished, with a strong interest in research and public policy, are encouraged to apply



Hold a master's degree

(earned between 2022 and 2026) in fields such as:

Public Policy, Law, Economics, Political Science, Public Management, Sociology, Sustainability, Environment, Information Technology, Statistics, Mathematics, or Engineering.



Demonstrate strong academic performance

Minimum GPA equivalent to "Very Good."



Meet english proficiency requirements

IELTS Academic 6.5 or TOEFL ibt 80 (may be waived for graduates of institutions in native-English-speaking countries).



Successfully pass the interview process
